

TRAF3IP1 polyclonal antibody

BackGround:

The protein encoded by this gene interacts with TNF receptor-associated factor 3, tethering it to cytoskeletal microtubules. The encoded protein is also an inhibitor of the innate type I IFN response. Defects in this gene are a cause of Senior-Loken syndrome 9.

1mg/ml in PBS with 0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol, pH7.2

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen and the purity is > 95% (by SDS-PAGE).

Storage&Stability:


Store at 4 $^{\rm C}$ short term. Aliquot and store at -20 $^{\rm C}$ long

term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using TRAF3IP1 antibody at 1:1000 dilution.
Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:10000 dilution.
br/>Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane.
br/>Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST.
br/>Detection: ECL Basic Kit .
br/>Exposure time: 3s.
